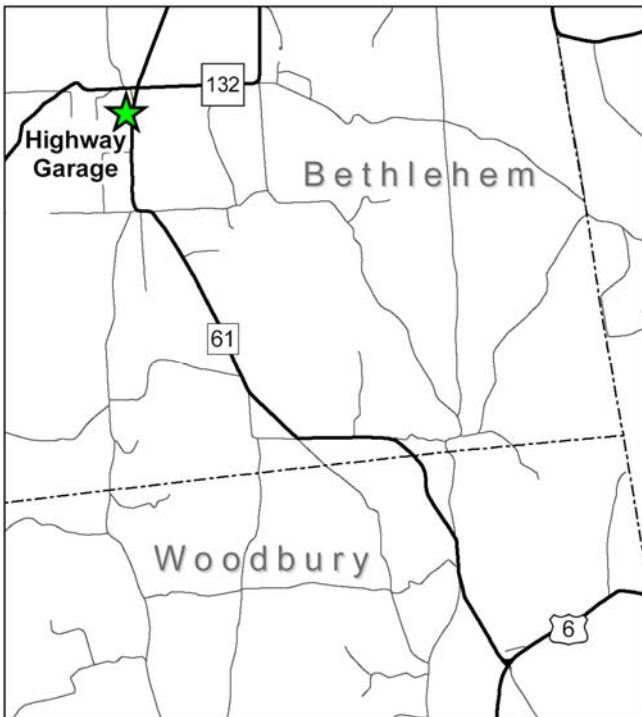


## Highway Garage

**From Route 8 North:** Take Exit 35 onto route 73. Continue on route 63. Turn left at route 6. Turn right at route 61. Highway garage is on left.

**From I-84 West:** Take Exit 15 and turn right onto Rte 6/67. Keep right at fork to continue on route 6. Turn left at route 61. Highway garage is on left.



## Guidelines to Follow

- ⇒ Upon entering the parking lot, a volunteer will request your identification and ask you to open the trunk of your vehicle in order to identify the type of waste you have.
- ⇒ You will be given a questionnaire requesting your name and address.
- ⇒ You will then be directed to the collection area.
- ⇒ The collection begins at 8:00 A.M. sharp and moves quickly.
- ⇒ **Being the first in line at 7:30 A.M. only ensures that you will wait an additional 30 minutes.**

## What is Household Hazardous Waste?

Any waste produced in the home that is poisonous, flammable, explosive, reactive, or corrosive is considered a household hazardous or chemical waste (note: explosives are not accepted at this HHW Collection).

If not properly disposed, these wastes can be harmful to human health and the environment. Do not pour these wastes down the drain, dump "out back," or throw in the trash.

Be sure to bring identification, such as a driver's license (preferred), a tax bill, a utility bill, or a transfer station sticker. **There is NO CHARGE for this service.**

## What's Accepted at the Event?

### Kitchen/Bathroom:

- ✓ Disinfectants
- ✓ Drain & oven cleaners
- ✓ Metal polishes
- ✓ Toilet bowl cleaners
- ✓ Aerosols
- ✓ Wood cleaners, polishes, and waxes
- ✓ Floor, upholstery and rug cleaners
- ✓ Bug & pest spray

### Garage/Workshop:

- ✓ Lead & oil-based paint
- ✓ Fluorescent bulbs
- ✓ Wood stains, varnishes, and sealants
- ✓ Paint thinner, stripper, and other solvents
- ✓ Lacquer & lacquer thinner
- ✓ Fungicides & wood treating chemicals
- ✓ Antifreeze
- ✓ Automotive cleaners and fluids
- ✓ Grease & rust solvents

### Garden/Hobby:

- ✓ Insecticides
- ✓ Poisons
- ✓ Pool chemicals
- ✓ Photo chemicals



## What **NOT** to Bring!

***\*LATEX PAINT IS NOT ACCEPTED\****

### Proper disposal of latex paint

- ◆ Cans containing 1/2" or less: Open lid and air dry
- ◆ Cans with paint in excess of 1/2": Add kitty litter or speedy dry to paint to accelerate drying

### Dispose of dried paint can in trash

Tips for identifying Latex and Oil-based paints:

- ◆ Latex is water-based
- ◆ Latex cleanup uses soap-and-water
- ◆ Oil-based paints are commonly referred to as "alkyd"

***NO LATEX PAINT*** (It is not considered hazardous)  
**No** Car batteries (Check with your town recycling center)  
**No** Motor oil (Same as batteries)  
**No** Explosives  
**No** Medical or biological waste  
**No** Commercial or industrial waste  
**No** PCB's  
**No** Asbestos  
**No** Medicines  
**No** Tires  
**No** Smoke detectors  
**No** Empty containers of any kind  
**No** Freon  
**No** Propane tanks
